

TEACHER CONTEST INFORMATION

It will be the teacher's responsibility to relay all of the contest information to each of their students. A good idea is to write a student's day, time, class, contestant number, and room on the inside cover of their music.

Teachers can forward their students the information or print out the materials to distribute to them. We are asking the teachers to be conscientious about getting their students the needed information.

*If a student has changed their song, do NOT notify us. The student can simply tell the Room Captain at the start of their class that their song has changed. The new selection must be in the same level and on the Required Lists in Piano, Violin, Cello, and Viola classes.

*The students should be told to report directly to their room. They will check in there at the start of their class.

*At this point in time, no more day or time changes will be accepted.

*Every student will receive an award, either a trophy or a ribbon. Students will need to take their score sheet to the trophy table on the 1st floor to pick up their award.

*All 1st Place Trophy Winners as well as ALL Memorial Contest Participants are invited to attend a free Winners' Recital, the date TBA. Information will be given to all eligible students. Last year's inaugural recital was a huge success. Space is very limited so students must sign up as soon as possible to be guaranteed a spot.

In order for the contest to run smoothly for your students' benefit, approximately 40 volunteers are needed at a minimum to assist the judges in contest rooms.
